With \$1 billion in sales in fiscal 2015, Versum Materials is comprised of two primary business segments, Materials (~75% revenues) and Delivery Systems and Services (~25% revenues). It participates in six of seven key semiconductor process steps, supplying high purity specialty process gas, cleaners and etchants, slurries, organosilanes and organometallics deposition films, and equipment. Versum, headquartered in Tempe, Arizona, has approximately 1,900 employees, 14 manufacturing and six research and development facilities in the Americas and Asia.
